Minutes of the Meeting

Mrs Harinder Oberai - Supervisor welcomed the PTA members and greeted them. The Meeting started at 8 : 15 a.m. 14 PTA members attended the meeting. Each and every point of the agenda was discussed by the Principal Mrs Deepa Jayaroy.

The Principal updated the PTA members regarding achievements of our students, won by them in various inter school competitions and external exams for the year 2024-25.

Certain results are awaited was also informed to them. The other points were as follow.

Affiliation:

The Principal informed about the affiliation and also spoke about its delay and various reasons related to it. She thanked the PTA for their support.

The PTA members applauded and also congratulated her for her dedication and hard work that was involved to achieve the same.

Introduction Of Paid Activities within the School Time Table:

The Principal explained the importance of activities. Only studies will not help the students for their holistic development. It is very important to get on the field and diverge their energy for that there are many issues at both the ends. So the school has come up with an excellent idea to keep the activities in school timetable. Many activities like Football, Table Tennis, Tabla, and Bharat Natyam will be introduced. It was clearly informed the minimum number should be 20 for each activity. The activities will not be burden on parents pocket, in fact they will be pocket friendly.

Total periods allotted for the activities are 4 that comes 2 hours weekly 2 days are allotted for activities. One day the activities will be shared with MD / Yoga.

Primary Skill Assessment Activity Based:

Skill based assessments are designed to measure the knowledge, skills and judgement required for competency in a given domain. This year in primary section few chapters will be done activity based. They will be assessed on skill basis. This will be done to develop the creativity in students. To enhance the various skills they possess, this will also help the teachers to measure the knowledge the student requires for various competency.

Discipline:

1. **Bullying and Abusive Language:** PTA members were informed about the abusive language the students are using. A fine would be imposed on them if they are caught using foul language. Bullying is also a concern; they are body shaming and bullying. If students are caught doing so fine would be imposed on them.

2. **Hair Cut, Nails trimmed, Neat Uniform, Socks and Shoes:** The students should come neatly dressed to school, they should wear clean and ironed uniform with clean socks and polished shoes.

3. **Vandalizing the School Property:** If the students are found vandalizing the school property then they have to mend or replace and give it to school or they will have to pay the school to repair. Or else will be deducted from the Caution money.

4. **Taking half day after exams and coming late for exams:** Students will not be allowed to take half day after exams until there is an emergency. Students will not be allowed to enter the examination hall after 15 mins of the time given to the students. If the students don't follow the rules and regulations the school will give 3 warnings and then one written note after that suspension and then termination.

Fee Collection

Principal Ma'am informed the PTA about the pending fees which is about 15 lacs for the Academic year 2024-25. She also applauded the parents who paid on time. She asked to convey the message to the other parents to kindly clear the fees by 25th of March, 2025.

Fee Hike:

Principal ma'am informed the PTA members that management has proposed to hike the fees by 12 %. To which the parents reacted in a negative way. Ma'am then informed the second proposal was 10%.

To which they enquired if it is going to be every year or this year only.

Ma'am explained them as if now it is for the current year.

Activities and Competitions for the year 2024-25:

Various activities and competitions were conducted for the year 2024-25 for example; Gudi Padwa, Diwali, Card making, Gandhi Jayanthi, Independence Day, Science Day, Hindi Diwas, Quiz competition.

A PPT was displayed which gave a glimpse of all the activities conducted throughout the year.

Introduction of Caution Money:

A sum of Rupees 5000/- will be taken from all the parents as caution money for any wear and tear of the school property by the student. If the student fails to pay any fine which will be levied on them the amount will be deducted from the caution money. This amount is refundable when the student will take TC from the school.

Introducing the School Counsellor:

Miss Laxmi Nair the School counsellor was introduced to the PTA members. She spoke about the issues faced by the students and school.

She briefed about Time Management, Stress Management, Behaviour Issues of the students.

School Assembly will be conducted class wise every week: Parents were informed that School Assembly will be conducted hereafter.

Principal ma'am thanked all the PTA members for their support, encouragement and continuous cooperation. As there were no further points to be discussed meeting was ended with the Vote of Thanks by the CCPC Suresh Kanakraj. Thereafter refreshments were served for all the members.
