Grade	Activity
I-III	Theme: Introduction to Nature & Responsibility Nature Walk & Scavenger Hunt – Identify plants, insects, and birds. Plant a Seed – Each student plants a seed in a cup and takes care of it.
IV-V	Theme: Learning About Impact & Action GRADE 4: DIY Bird Feeder or Bug Hotel – Use recycled materials. GRADE 5: Water Filtration Science Experiment – Simple and hands-on.
VI-VIII	Theme: Critical ThinkingGRADE 6: Up-cycling Workshop – Turn old clothes into bags, or bottles into planters.GRADE 7: Environmental Debate – Topics such as "Should plastic be banned?" or "Nuclear vs. Renewable Energy".GRADE 8: Group research and presentation on topics including Earth's formation, Antarctica's significance and current environmental challenges.
IX	Theme: Earth & Nature Host an Earth Day rally or event where students can share their environmental awareness messages and pledges.
