APRIL	1. NUMBERS UP TO 20	<p>ORDERS OF NUMBERS (ACT) *By using cards with numbers written from 1 to 20. Students will read the number on their card and sit in increasing order while displaying the cards. *Hide number cards around the classroom divide students into small group kids will find the number and arrange in order</p>
JUNE	2. ADDITION UP TO 10	<p>NUMBE LINE JUMP (ACT) Teacher will draw number line from 1 to 10. Teacher will start at a number ex, 2 . Teacher will ask students to jump forward(e.g, +3jumps) land on 5. Student will also write answer in notebooks (2+3=5).</p>
JULY	3. SUBTRACTION UP TO 10	<p>SUBTRACTION WITH THE HELP OF MODEL (TLM) BUS Subtraction Hopscotch Game: 1. Draw Circles: Create a path of circles on the floor with sums (e.g., 8-3, 5-2). 2. Start: Kids stand at the first circle. 3. Solve & Jump: Solve the sum (e.g., 8-3=5), jump to the next circle. 4. Win: Reach the end circle first!</p>
AUGUST	4. SHAPES 5. ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION UP TO 20	<p>CREATE AN INTERESTING PICTURE WITH THE HELP OF GRID PAPER.(ACT) Student will draw simple shapes (Square, rectangle, triangle) inside the boxes to create a picture like a house, tree, or robot in thier notebook. Teacher will guide them to follow the lines properly.</p>
SEPTEMBER	6. NUMBERS UP TO 50 7. MEASUREMEN T	<p>ADDITION GREATER NUMBERS WITH THE HELP OF MODEL (TLM) Students wil use bundles of sticks to understand bigger number. Teacher will show addition ex. 23+15, using tens and ones. Students will practice similar sums using materials and write answers in notebooks.</p> <p>MEASURING LENGTH WITH DIFFERENTS UNITS Students will measure objects like pencil, book, desk using non-standard units like handspan, fingers, or scales. Teacher will demonstrate for understandng. Student will compare long/short objects.</p>
OCTOBER	8. NUMBERS UP TO 100	<p>Math (ACT) Activity using 10×1 strips and small squares to teach place value (tens and ones). Explanation of the Method:Make pairs of children. 2. Materials: Give each pair strips (representing tens) and small squares (representing ones). 3. Action: One child picks a few strips and squares.The other child says the number of tens and ones picked.Then they state the actual number formed (e.g., 3 strips + 4 squares = 34).</p>

NOVEMBER	9. ADDITION AND SUBTRACTION UP TO 99	Number line jumps : Use number line to practice jumps forward (addition) and backward (subtraction)
DECEMBER	10. TIME AND MONEY	MAKE A PAPER WALL CLOCK.(ACT) Students will make a simple clock using paper plate/cardboard. They will draw numbers 1-12 and fix movable hand using a pin. Teacher will ask students to show different times. BUY AND SELL GAME Teacher will arrange a small "small shop" then place items with price tags. Teacher will divide students into shopkeeper and customers. customers use fake money to buy items and shopkeeper counts and give items. Teacher help students to count money correctly.
JANUARY	11. DATA HANDLING	FAVOURITE FRUIT GRAPH Teacher will ask students their favourite fruite(Apple, Banana, Mango , etc.). Teacher will record answers on board. Students have to draw a simple pictograph. Student will observed that data , count and compare which fruit is most/least liked.
FEBRUARY	12. PATTERNS 13. INTRODUCTION TO MULTIPLICATION AND DIVISION	COLOUR AND SHAPE PATTERNS Teacher will provide some pattern like  . Student will repeat the same thing by drawing in their notebook and colour it. Student will create their own patterns and share with class. SHARING EQUALLY Teacher will arrange students into groups of 5 each and provide plates to represent groups. Teacher will give chocolates to each group and ask students in each group to share the chocolates equally in plates.
